Project Background

Timisoara is a strong regional center, where creativity supports the experiment and where the dynamics of cultural life is connected to the international phenomenon.

In the context of a Cultural Strategy for the city of Timişoara, the Faculty of Arts and Design within the West University of Timişoara aims to join independently the desire for this city to become the European Capital of Culture in 2023.

The **FISART Group** formed by the Faculty of Arts and Design (FAD) of UVT, EnduRoMania Foundation, X-TEC SRL and the international community of artists initiated and developed the International Street Art Festival (FISART) between 2011 and 2020, within the calendar of events of the Timişoara City Hall (PMT). The members of the **FISART Group** had the opportunity to participate in several professional and academic conferences and for the practical realization of Street Art works, which took place in various cities in Europe. It was concluded that such an international conference should be organized also in Timişoara, which this year we proposed to be held under the name of "**International On-Line Conference for Street Art and Urban Regeneration**".

Due to the pandemic, the "<u>Virtual FISART - Making Street Art from Home</u>" tool was conceived in March 2020 to give mural artists, architects, urban planners and traditional visual artists the possibility of virtual creation.

After the positive evolution of the "Virtual FISART - Making Street Art from Home" on line platform, we came to the conclusion to present it in the framework of the "International On line Conference for Street Art and Urban Regeneration".

Conference Take Aways and Next Steps

- 1. We are building a global transversal network of specialists around Street Art & Urban Regeneration in order to scale contemporary art to urban growth factor, all stakeholders involved so far are interested.
- 2. Global cross sector brainstormings are a golden mine to find ideal solutions for urban regeneration all around the globe by broadening our perspectives and applying the best in class solutions and/or available success stories.
- 3. A global social media platform based on the Virtual FISART Making Street Art from Home" idea may unite our efforts and would increase our individual and collective impact at the same time.
- 4. Private and public involvement are necessary in order to ensure the longevity of our Street HeART cause.
- 5. A Street heART Contemporary Art museum in Timisoara would be a major cultural beacon for art and culture in general, seen in the European Capital of Culture 2023 context.
- 6. A STREET HeART United Alliance // FISART Global Network (similar to UNITA in the academic world) would be an excellent global Modus Operandi/ formula to move forward.

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
